Should the fund continue to grow due to additional donations, the grants will be awarded on a rolling basis.

Grant applications will be reviewed by the Foundation's staff. The Foundation reserves the right to reject in whole, or in part, any grant application that it deems to be incomplete or not in accordance with the mission and policies set forth by the Foundation.
